^{*} This capital campaign is the final one required by the loan committee of the Presbyterian Church (USA) for the current mortgage. This \$400,000 mortgage amount will allow the church to begin phasing mortgage payments into the annual operating budget within the next five to six years (possibly earlier should the annual Stewardship Campaign warrant adding a mortgage line item; mortgage payments thus far have been paid from capital campaigns).

^{**} The Fellowship Hall will be constructed if a total of \$800,000 is pledged to the overall campaign. Debt reduction of the original building is the first priority. The estimate for the construction of the Fellowship Hall is \$350,000-\$400,000. Should construction costs be at the low end of that range, paving all (or a portion) of the parking lot may be possible depending upon bids received for consideration. Your pledge, in combination with many others, will bring this dream to reality. Thank you.

^{***} Two couples have stepped forward to offer a \$400,000 match of the congregation's pledges so that mortgage and interest on the original structure can be paid down by \$400,000 and so that a Fellowship Hall can be built (approximately \$350,000 to \$400,000). All members of the congregation are asked to prayerfully consider a pledge over four tax years (2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019) to the maximum amount possible so that the challenge match can be secured, allowing the Session to move forward with additional debt reduction and construction of a wonderful addition to our church's campus for all to enjoy.
