CHATHAM SOLIDARITY FUND - Over the next few weeks, the Mission and Service Committee will be offering information on opportunities to help those affected by the COVID-19 shutdown. We realize our congregation has been affected by this crisis in different ways. Some may wish to give portions of the recent government stimulus to others in the larger community. We can all be aware of some wonderful partnerships in our larger community that are making a positive difference for those in need.

This week we would like to highlight The Chatham Solidarity Fund. This a joint fundraising effort by the Hispanic Liaison, Habitat for Humanity, Chatham Partnership for Children, Chatham Literacy Council, CORE (Chatham Organizing for Racial Equity) and others. The goal is to raise \$360,000 by May 20th. The Fund is designed to help those in Chatham County who will not receive stimulus checks or unemployment benefits. Non-US citizens, regardless of immigration status, do not qualify for these funds, although these workers pay Federal, State, and SS taxes. Neither do American citizens, such as children whose parents are non-US citizens, receive any of these funds.
