Jesus Christ, the true vine, in our need we ask forgiveness, for we too easily become dry and lifeless without connection to your life-giving spirit.


We confess the mistakes we have made, and the good we have left undone. As we come closer to your presence, our lives are drawn closer to others, for everything that rises must converge.

Large print worship bulletins, Bibles and hymnals are available from the ushers. Handicapped parking is available in front of the church with level access into the sanctuary.


