All: And to remind us that God is with us today.




PRAYER FOR COURAGE - Pádraig Ó Tuama Courage comes from the heart and we are always welcomed by God, the heart of our being.



Thank you for the grace that nourishes and sustains our faith, both as individuals and as the body of your Beloved Son.


Inspire the ministry of this church, that we would be united in loving service to one another and the larger community. In the name of the Prince of Peace, amen.
