What an awesome decision it was to purchase solar panels! According to our inverter website dashboard, on July 17, 2019 at 9:15am we started producing our first amount of solar energy. Since then as of last week, morning we have replaced enough electricity to prevent 321,775 pounds of CO₂ from being released into the atmosphere if it needed to be produced by a fossil fuel plant. To pull that much CO₂ out of the air would have required 2431 trees. This is AMAZING!!! Let's just keep making smart decisions that affect our community and our planet.






