
STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN IS AT 90% OF GOAL

They are currently reading and discussing Jim Wallis's Book *The False White Gospel.*






We hope you will be able to worship with us Christmas Eve at our 4pm and/or 7pm services. Nursery care will be available at both services.

Pastor's Musing

Finally, Comes the Poet

"Suppose we did our work like the snow," Wendell muses Berry, "quietly, quietly, leaving nothing out." It's been too long since I've witnessed the beauty of snow blanketing the yard and woods. However, during our time in the mountains, Ginny and I would spend mornings gazing at the falling snowflakes while snuggling on the appropriately named loveseat.

Quietly, quietly, until the kids awoke.

Here in the South, snow shuts everything down. It's countercultural to avoid being frenetic and busy, but Berry argues that snow is actually more effective because it doesn't omit anything. In "How to Be a Poet," Berry urges writers to "make a poem that does not disturb the silence from which it came." Could we all work like that? Perhaps pray like that?

A word search in the Bible for quietness revealed a poignant verse: "In returning and rest, you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength" (Isaiah 30:15). Salvation and strength suggest something more than the lack of noise, something like the prayer found in yet another Berry poem, "We pray to be quiet in heart and in eye clear." May it be so.
