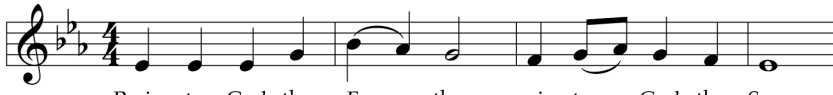
Then the soldiers took Jesus, put a crown of thorns upon His head...
