<u>Faith Formation</u> looks to add to the selection of children's Bibles for Worship with *God's Stories by God's People*. From Joelle: We were fortunate to receive a grant from the Wonder of Worship initiative to purchase 2 sets of children's Bibles to use in worship. While these two titles cover many (about 1/2) of the readings that come up in the Revised Common Lectionary cycle, they still do not represent the entire "adult" Bible. A new children's Bible title was released recently (*God's Stories by God's People*) and it fills in many of the gaps in the other titles. We would like to build a set (20 copies) of this title so that we are able to align Time With Young Disciples with the Revised Common Lectionary on a more consistent basis. Questions? Communications & Technology recently worked with a specialist to review our sanctuary technology and modernize our audio-visual equipment.
