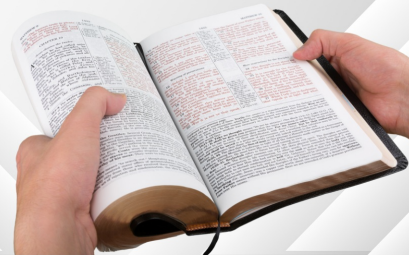

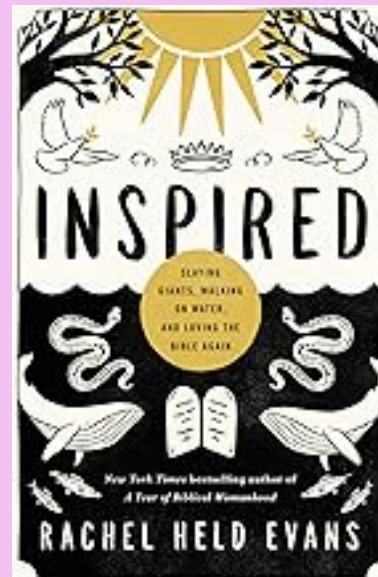

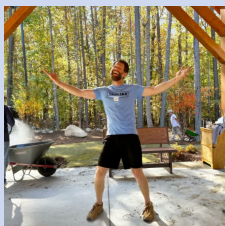

PASTOR'S MUSING



Finally, Comes the Poet

In scripture, the Holy Spirit is mentioned in several ways: as tongues of fire, as wind, as "the sound of silence" (1 Kings 19:13). Celtic Christians used their holy imagination to envision yet another symbol – a "wild goose" (in Gaelic, *an geadh-glas* which is pronounced "a god-gloss"). While differing from the image of a dove that descended upon Jesus at his baptism (see Matthew 3:16; Luke 3:22), I think it's fun to think about and write about!

An Geadh-Glas

Holy Spirit as dove,
wholly meek and holy gentle,
descending from sunlight,
a picture-perfect photo.
Holy Spirit as "wild goose,"
beating her strong wings
& hissing like a cobra
to protect her young brood,
fuzzy-wuzzy goslings who,
like us, wander with little clue.
Nothing silly about this Ma Goose
or cute like a nursery rhyme,
but honking flying power,
loyalty, and love divine.
