




Shakespeare's Julius Caesar

Join us as we read together and discuss Shakespeare's historical tragedy play about an actual historical event—the demise of the Roman general and statesman, Julius Caesar.

WEEKLY CHOIR REHEARSALS!








**LITERACY VOLUNTEERS

Dear Love to Know,

Last March, I was one of the chaperones for our youth weekend trip. We went to Raleigh, stayed at First Presbyterian Church, and volunteered at an emergency shelter for people who are experiencing homelessness. This shelter was operated as a ministry by St. John's Metropolitan Community Church. On Sunday morning, we worshipped with the congregation of St. John's, and they taught us the benediction:

I am created by God. I am beloved by God. I am called by God.

You are created by God. You are beloved by God. You are called by God.

We are created by God. We are beloved by God. We are called by God.

The Metropolitan Community Church is a denomination created in 1968 specifically for members of the LGBTQ community. At that time, no Christian denomination was openly accepting and affirming, so clergy leaders formed a new denomination. Good for them!

St. John's began in Raleigh in 1976. Their current pastor, Vance, came to serve on the exact Sunday that I came to Chapel in the Pines—January 21, 2018. I continue to have a friendship with Vance because he is a man of deep, abiding faith. He likes to say that the church is about “putting our words into actions.”

Therefore, I brought the benediction to Chapel in the Pines approximately nine months ago, partly due to the youth's fondness for it, partly as a tribute to St. John's, and partly because it deviates from the conventional Presbyterian worship style. It can feel somewhat cheesy. Nevertheless, the theology is beautiful: we are created, beloved, and called. And sometimes it's good, even holy, to feel a little uncomfortable. It might be the Spirit nudging you to go outside the box.
