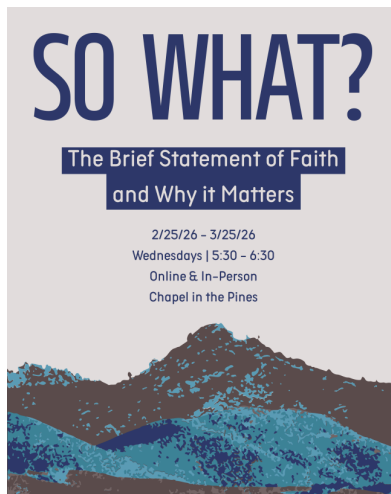


## ASH WEDNESDAY

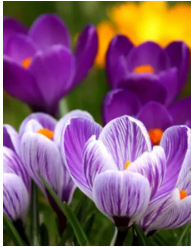
