If you were here this past Sunday for worship, you heard Selina Lopez speak about the Orgullo Latinx Pride. We, at Chapel in the Pines, partner with this group doing great things for our Latinx youth in Chatham County.

Below is a message sent to us from Selina to share with you:

Many of you know me as Selina, Program Director of the incredible Orgullo Latinx Pride (OLP) Youth Program. Today, I wanted to ask a small but heartfelt question: Will you be my Valentine? ❤️

For the next 14 days, we are highlighting the impact of our work through our Show Your Love campaign as we raise funds to continue supporting Latinx youth and families in our community.

OLP is truly work from the heart, work that sits very close to mine and fuels my purpose every single day. Why? Because, what some of you may not know about me is that I am a first-generation immigrant, an English as a Second Language learner, once undocumented youth, and the first in my family to graduate from high school and college. This May, I will also become the first in my family to earn a Master's degree.

I see my younger self reflected in the youth I work with every day. And just like them, I know I didn't get here alone. I had a village, people who believed in me, supported me, and showed up when it mattered most.

Today, I'm inviting you to be part of their village.






Dear Despairing,

At last Tuesday's fellowship dinner, a couple of our young disciples worked puzzles. They might not be ready for a national puzzle competition, like our intern Jordan, but they completed the tasks and were proud of themselves.

Your question brought them to mind because I, too, feel overwhelmed at times by the enormity of the problems in our community, country, and world. It helps me to focus on the task at hand or, better yet, the person in front of me.

Unlike a jigsaw puzzle, pieces of life don't always fit perfectly together. However, your effort might mean more than you think at the time. The way those young disciples supported one another warmed the hearts of their parents and other nearby adults.

Last Sunday, we welcomed two guest speakers from immigrant communities in Chatham County. Both mentioned how safe and welcomed they felt. I realize that, even when it seems like one church is not making much of a difference, we can actually make all the difference for one person. And isn't a puzzle solved one piece at a time?
