WHAT: Come learn or refresh your training on serving Communion for the 10am/11am worship service.

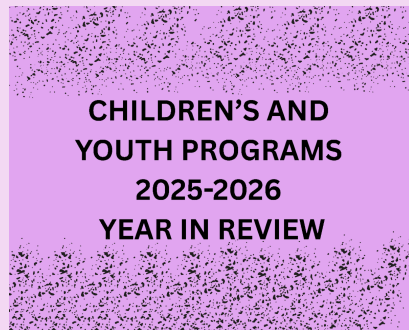

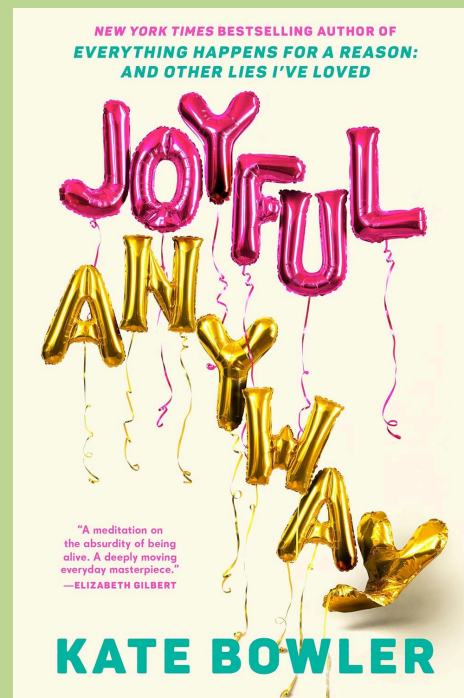

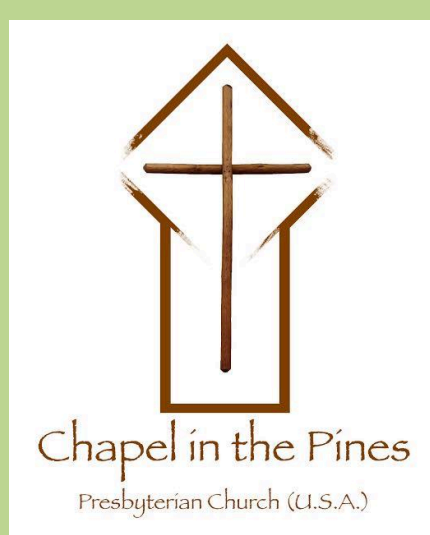
The group recently began reading the book *Joyful, Anyway* by Kate Bowler. We hope the ladies of CITP will join the group for that.
